

The Iowa County Board of Supervisors met January 27, 2017. Chairman Garringer called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Garringer, Huedepohl, Pope, Gahring, and Heitshusen were present.

Motion by Pope, seconded by Gahring to **approve the agenda**. All aye, motion carried.

Motion by Heitshusen, seconded by Gahring to **approve the minutes** from January 20 and January 24, 2017. All aye, motion carried.

Mark Zaccone, Invenergy Wind Energy updated the board on the progress of the wind turbine project. He noted that there will be approximately 125 turbines in Iowa County and that the project is entering a study phase and progress will likely slow down at this point.

2,000 Gal of DEF Fluid - \$1.90/gallon – Total: \$3,800
As needed premium additive: \$0.040/gallon
As needed winter additive: \$0.040/gallon - \$2,000
Grand Total: \$26,200.
