

The Iowa County Board of Supervisors met June 9, 2017. Chairman Garringer called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Garringer, Huedepohl, Pope, Gahring, and Heitshusen were present.

Motion by Pope, seconded by Heitshusen to **approve the agenda**. All aye, motion carried.

Motion by Heitshusen, seconded by Huedepohl to **approve the minutes** from June 2, 2017. All aye, motion carried.

Motion by Gahring, seconded by Pope to approve the **liquor license renewal for Ox Yoke Inn, Inc**, 4420 220th Trail, Amana, IA 52203. All aye, motion carried.

Motion by Gahring, seconded by Huedepohl, **approve the quarterly transfer of \$328,750.00 from Rural Basic fund to Secondary Roads fund**. All aye, motion carried

Nick Amelon, County Engineer met with the board to discuss construction, road maintenance, and other miscellaneous items in the secondary road department. He also gave the board an update on the Pioneer Cemetery Commission.

Motion by Gahring, seconded by Pope to **approve the Nick Amelon to carry over all of his unused vacation until October 1**. All aye, motion carried

Teresa Albert, Millstream Brewery met with the board to request road closures for several summer events.

There was concern from the Board about the road being completely closed and not allowing access to a home and an airport in the area. Another concern was the number of times the road would be closed. Ms. Albert would like to have just a small portion of the street closed for the band and not allow people to sit in the road. Nick Amelon offered to work with Teresa Albert to work on different scenarios to avoid closing the road.

Motion by Gahring, seconded by Huedepohl to **not approve the road closure request from Teresa Albert with Millstream Brewing Company**. All aye, motion carried.
