

The Iowa County Board of Supervisors met October 4, 2019. Chairman Garringer called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Garringer, Gahringer, Pope, Heitshusen, and Adams were present.

Motion by Pope, seconded by Heitshusen to approve **the agenda**. All aye, motion carried.

Motion by Adams, seconded by Heitshusen to **approve the minutes** from September 27, 2019. All aye, motion carried.

Chair Note: Board received Iowa County Drainage District Levee Report for the month of September. Board received Recorders Report of Fees Collected for period July 1, 2019 thru September 30, 2019. Board received Quarterly Report for Quarter ending September 30, 2019 from the Iowa County Auditor. Board received Sheriff's Office Balance Sheet for quarter ending September 30, 2019. Open Forum: Several Iowa County residents asked for a timeframe of getting a newly drafted wind ordinance and gave suggestions of what they would like to see happen with future wind projects.

Scot Wetjen, Building Maintenance, met with the Board to discuss the replacement of a part-time custodian that will be leaving in November.

Motion by Heitshusen, seconded by Adams to **approve the hiring of a part-time employee for the Building Maintenance Department not to exceed 24 hours per week. Starting wage will be based on previous experience**. All aye, motion carried.
