

Iowa County Civil Service Commission For Deputy Sheriffs

Notice is hereby given: an opening for a full-time position for Iowa County Deputy Sheriff is available. Testing will be done on Thursday, May 17th, 2018. The written test will begin at 10:30 a.m. at the Iowa County East Courthouse Annex, 970 Court Avenue, Marengo, Iowa. The physical fitness test will follow 30 minutes after the group completes the written test. The first portion of the physical fitness will be administered in the same room in the East Courthouse Annex as the written test. The running portion of the test will be held at the Iowa Valley Track.

Anyone interested in taking the examination must file written application with the Iowa County Auditor at least 15 days prior to the examination. **The application must be postmarked by or personally delivered by May 2, 2018 at 4:30 p.m.**

A fee of \$11.00 needs to accompany the application. Application forms are available at the Iowa County Auditor's Office, 970 Court Ave, Marengo, IA 52301. *****IMPORTANT NOTE TO APPLICANTS*****

If you have questions concerning the position, you may call the Iowa County Sheriff's Office between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday – Friday. 319-642-7307.

Applicant must present driver's license before testing.

The Auditor's Office is located in the East Courthouse Annex, which is across the street from the courthouse. Iowa Valley Track is located north of the courthouse in Marengo.

IMPORTANT NOTE FOR OFFICERS WHO ARE CURRENTLY CERTIFIED

Certified officers may lateral per "Lateral Transfer" rule. An applicant already in law enforcement can transfer without testing if they are without a break from service for not more than 180 days from law enforcement service.

APPLICANT WITH PRIOR TEST RESULTS

You will need to provide the Iowa County Auditor with the date you took the test and the Auditor will obtain your POST score from the Stanard Company. **Notification of a previous POST test must be given to the Iowa County Auditor before May 17th, 2018.** If you have previously taken the tests, you may re-take them if you wish, however, your latest test scores will be the ones considered for this position.

You will also need to obtain a certified copy of your physical fitness test from the auditor (or caretaker of the scores) and provide that to the Iowa County Auditor. **Physical results need to be mailed or faxed to the Auditor's office before May 17, 2018.**
